Student Assistant (m/f/d) for the project FLESH

As part of the project "On the Flexibility and Stability of gesture-speech coordination: Evidence from production, comprehension, and imitation (FLESH)" at the Leibniz Centre for General Linguistics (ZAS) in Berlin, a student assistant position (40 hours/month á 13,69 €) is offered from 01 Sept 2024.

The tasks include support in the annotation of experimental audiovisual data (e.g. in Praat and Elan), minor programming work (e.g. in Python, Praat, R) and support in administrative tasks. Knowledge in these areas is an advantage. Conversation in the team takes place in English, so basic knowledge of this language is desirable.
